
Dormition of the Theotokos Activity Book



Read the Account of the Dormition of the Theotokos

One day Mother Mary was praying on the Mount of Olives. Suddenly the Angel Gabriel appeared to her and told her that in a few days she would be taken up to Heaven by her Son, the Lord Jesus Christ. Mother Mary was filled with joy.

She immediately told the believers and sent word to the Apostles, who were in many different parts of the world, because she wanted to see them one last time. As soon as the Apostles got the news they started traveling to Jerusalem to see Mother Mary. They all loved her very much. Some of the Apostles were so far away and would not be able to make it in time. Church tradition says that they were miraculously transported to Jerusalem by angels. The only Apostle who did not make it in time was St. Thomas.

At the appointed time Mother Mary was laying on her bed waiting to be taken to Heaven. While she was surrounded by the Apostles, her friends and believers, the Lord Jesus Christ appeared. He was accompanied by angels who were singing beautifully. It was then that He took her soul with him to Heaven.

The Apostles and the Disciples carried her body in a sad procession towards the Garden of Gethsemane. They buried her nearby. The funeral took 3 days because there were so many people gathered from many areas surrounding Jerusalem and they all wanted to pay their respects to the Mother of God.

On the third day the Apostle St. Thomas arrived. He was so sad that he had not come in time to see Mother Mary. He begged the other Apostles to let him see her body. They opened the grave and to everyone's surprise the body was not there! They understood that the body had been taken to Heaven by the Lord. Almost immediately an angel appeared to them and confirmed that the body of the Holy Theotokos had been taken by her Son, the Lord Jesus Christ into Heaven.







Listen to the Ancient Hyms of the Dormition of Mother Mary While You Color the Picture

Mother Mary is our example to follow and that is why her life and death are so significant for us. She is the first believer and evangelist in regard to her Son who is the 'Source of Life', and that is why she is called the 'Mother of Life.'

The Apolytikion of the Dormition

In birth, you preserved your virginity; in death, you did not abandon the world, O Theotokos. As mother of life, you departed to the source of life, delivering our souls from death by your intercessions.

The Kontakion of the Dormition

Neither the grave nor death could contain the Theotokos, the unshakable hope, ever vigilant in intercession and protection. She being the Mother of life, He who dwelt in the ever-virginal womb transposed her to life.
