Read the Account of the Nativity of the Theotokos

St. Joachim and St. Anna were a devout elderly couple. They were very faithful to God. But there was one thing that made them very sad, they did not have any children. Because of this people looked down on them and even said mean things to them. This made them even more sad.

One day St. Joachim went to the wilderness to spend time praying for God to give them a child. He stayed there for 40 days and 40 nights. At the same time his wife, St. Anna was praying in Jerusalem. At the end of 40 days an angel appeared to both of them and told them that they would have a baby. And this baby would be known throughout the world.

St. Joachim and St. Anna were filled with joy at the news. Sure enough, just as the angel had said, St. Anna conceived and she gave birth to a baby girl. That baby was St.Mary, who would later become the Mother of Jesus.

Why do we celebrate on September 8th?

Every year we celebrate the birth of St. Mary on September 8th. The church chose this date because in the 4th century St. Helena, the mother of Emperor Constantine built a church and dedicated it to the Nativity of the Theotokos on September 8th.

From where do we get the account?

The account of St.Mary's birth is not recorded in the Bible. It has been passed on to us by the Protevangelion (Gospel of St. James).

What do we call St. Mary's parents

We call the parents of St. Mary, 'The Holy and Righteous Ancestors of God, St. Joachim and St. Anna.


Read about the Icon of the Nativity of the Theotokos



Around her are the attendants (ladies) who are assisting her. In the crib beside Anna's bed we see the baby, St. Mary. St. Joachim's and St. Anna's hands are both pointing towards St. Mary.





Connect the dots and color the picture to make a surprise for Baby Mary!!
